The regular February meeting of the PSLRA Board of Directors was held Wednesday, February 22. Minutes of the January meeting were approved as submitted by email.

**Secretary's Report:** Judges were approved for the match by email.

**Correspondence:** Petdoors contacted our webmaster stating they had placed a link to PSLRA.org on their website and asked to have a corresponding link to their business placed on our website. This request was denied.

**Treasurer's Report:** \$15,777.94 total funds including \$3,920.44 in special rescue funds. There have been some problems with customer service at our current bank and Darlene was given permission to look into the possibility of changing banks in 2007.

**Acknowledgements:** Thanks were extended to to Becky Jack for hosting the meeting, to Beckie Jensen and Ron Perry for chairing the January banquet, to Sharon Edwards for the Junior Awards at the banquet, to Jan Palumbo and Nina Mann for chairing the Show 'n Go and to Cheri Levine for coordinating the club booth at the Sportsmen's Show.

### Committee Reports:

—*Spring Hunt Test:* Cheri Wildes reported that test plans are on track and volunteers are still needed. The judges slate was approved. It was moved and passed to have the judges' dinner catered by Dixie's Barbecue at a cost of \$300.

—*Specialty:* Vicky Hoskinson reports that we have our AKC approval in place. She still needs a judges' liaison. We discussed returning to a catered dinner in place of the potluck held on Saturday. Vicky will present more information about this possibility at a later date. Bea

Ferguson volunteered to coordinate the Battle of the Baskets. The idea presented for the Challenge Trophy in memory of Clary Tanner was approved.

—*5 Series:* The judges have been selected for the 5 series. Liz Skillingstad is looking for volunteers.

—*Fun Field Day:* The fun day at Greenleaf's is on track but Terrie Sato still needs volunteers.

**Old Business:** Discussion was held about judges' gifts.

—Nina Mann gave a report on the Show 'n Go. It was very successful with a great group of volunteers. Julie and Mike Germano were wonderful hosts.

—People have been asking to have single items of the club merchandise shipped to them. This makes inventory control difficult and is not something we should expect Debbie to do. It was decided that club merchandise will only be available for sale at club events.

# Reading with Jake and Abby

They volunteer an hour of their time every Friday at Poulsbo Elementary to work with children for whom English is their second language and Spanish is their primary language. These children come from First through Fourth Grade. Every Friday you will find Jake and Abby snuggled up to a child who sits next to them on a bean bag chair and reads to them, usually from a book about dogs. The children really get a kick out of reading to Jake and Abby because the dogs sit there and really listen. You see, the dogs tilt their heads like they truly are listening especially when they hear words they know such as *blankie*, *cookie* and *Buba*, which is Jake's nickname.

Not only is this fun for the children while helping to improve their reading skills, it has also built up their self-esteem. **LIST OF LITTERS BORN OR EXPECTED AS OF 3/12/06 that conform to the PSLRA Code of Ethics.** Information is as submitted by owners and provided as a service to the public. Listings of litters are in no way an endorsement by PSLRA of any litter or any one litter over another. Litters are removed from the list after three months.

To publish **LITTER LISTINGS** in the newsletter, the following information **must be available**:

- Elbows and hips must be certified on both the sire and dam. Dogs and bitches whelped before 5/1/87 are exempt from elbow clearance requirements and will be marked OFEL N/A. Prelims are not acceptable! The board has recently agreed to accept PennHip clearances that score in the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile or higher, passing Wind-Morgan clearances, and clearances from the Ontario Veterinary College (OVC) in Canada. Female Labradors (bitches) with a Wind-Morgan, Penn Hip, or OVC clearance must not be bred before the age of 20 months, or 24 months with an OFA clearance. Male Labradors (dogs) with a Wind-Morgan, Penn Hip or OVC clearance must not be bred before the age of 12 months, or 24 months with an OFA clearance.
  - Eye clearances on both parents annually. After the dog's examination at age 10, annual examinations are no longer necessary.
  - Heart clearances will be included in the listing at the discretion of the breeder.
  - A PSLRA member must own either the sire or the dam and must submit the listing for a non-member.
  - **Please contact Marlys if you need a Litter Listing form, to be used for ALL litters.**
  - All Breeders must update their litters each week with Marlys Swanson via email (marlyss982@aol.com) as to the sex and color of puppies you have sold. The listing will be deleted after three months from the first litter listing date unless she hears from you.
