



## Board Meeting Minutes

PSLRA Board Meeting Minutes

September 23, 2009

Issaquah Highlands Fire Station, Sammamish, WA

The meeting was called to order at 6:40 p.m. by President Stephanie Harris.

Officer/board attendance: Stephanie Harris, Terrie Sato, Ron Perry, Shelah Frey, Jennifer Hajny, Nina Mann, Mary Jane Sarbaugh, Sarah Fischer, Jill Mahoney, Gail Gegg, Toni Leitao, and Lucy Isaacson-Logen.

**Minutes:** Minutes from the August 26, 2009 board meeting were approved, with previous edits suggested on e-mail.

### Officer Reports

**President:** Stephanie greeted everyone and launched into the evening's agenda.

**Secretary:** Correspondence: the club received letters from AKC closing out the fall hunt test. The Master National Retriever Club sent out proposed changes in the qualifications for the Master National hunt test, and a copy was circulated. An e-mail from Retriever News requested the club mailing list and the request was turned down, based on club policy not to provide the list for commercial purposes.

**Treasurer:** Current balance in checking is \$16,738

### Acknowledgements

Thanks to everyone who volunteered at the fall hunt test. Thanks to Shelah for securing a location for the October board/membership meeting.

### Committee Reports

**Membership:** Board accepted membership applications from Cindy McElroy, Clinton and Maricres Talley, Angela Moffet, and David Black.

**Fall Agility Trial:** Final preparations are in the works. The club may need to borrow canopies to compensate for the ones that are broken and need to be replaced.

**Fall Hunt Test:** Shelah Frey provided a financial report on the event. At present, the event made about \$1,200, but not all bills have been received.

**Fall Working Certificate:** Everything seems to be ready for the event on 9/26.

**Specialty:** Jennifer Hajny asked about what source of funds to use in the future to purchase \$150 worth of items for the raffle. The board suggested using rescue funds, since the raffle benefits rescue, and the raffle adds a lot of revenue to the rescue account. The board

discussed how to pay for judges' airline tickets (e.g., prepayment by the club or reimbursement of the judge). The board members preferred the latter method with the understanding that the judge would try to find the best price.

**Health Clinic:** Mary Jane Sarbaugh said the annual clinic will be held Sunday, September 27 at Cascade Kennels in Woodinville. The number of CERF exam applications is already full.

**Tracking Test:** The premium for the October 25 (Sunday) test at Carlson's Farm, Fall City, was distributed.

### Old Business

**Policy Review:** The board discussed the proposed changes and suggested several more. The proposals will be again discussed at the October membership meeting.

**T-Shirts:** About half have been sold through pre-orders. Sweatshirts will be available next month. Contact Nina Mann for more information.

**Sweeps at the January 2010 Puyallup Shows:** The AKC approved sweeps judges Ken Matthews and Pam Sage. Gail Gegg will check with the superintendent regarding judges' hospitality and distribution of the sweeps prize money.

### New Business

**Club Volunteers Wanted:** Stephanie reported that the club is looking for volunteers for the following positions in the club:

- Trophy sponsorship at the specialty
- Litter Listing/Puppy Referral chair person
- Newsletter editor
- Chair of the club booth at the Seattle Kennel Club shows.

Jill Mahoney volunteered to take responsibility for litter listings, etc.

If members wish to volunteer for any of the above duties, which are important to the club, please contact Stephanie.

**Club Show Trailer:** Mary Jane Sarbaugh reported that there are several unused items in the trailer that are taking up space and adding to the weight to the trailer. She proposed surplussing the unnecessary items by first asking the original donors (if known) if they would like them returned and recycling anything that is unwanted or unclaimed. She will prepare an inventory of those items.

**Nominating Committee:** Stephanie announced that Barbara Ironside agreed to chair the nominating committee. The rest of the members of the committee

will be announced once they are submitted to the board. If you are interested, please contact Stephanie or Barbara.

#### Open Discussion:

**LQ Ad:** The board discussed the desirability of taking out an ad at club expense in the Labrador Quarterly announcing all of the titles earned in 2009 by Labradors owned and/or bred by club members. A motion to approve the advertisement was moved, seconded, and approved. Laura Berger and Lee Foote will collect the information. Sarah Fischer suggested that members whose dogs qualify for the ad should send a photo too, so that she can assemble a collage of all of the title winners. Check the newsletter for details.

**LRC Raffle:** Nina asked the board if it wished to donate smoked salmon to the national specialty raffle, as was customary. It was moved, seconded and approved to donate the smoked salmon to the raffle.

#### Adjournment

The meeting adjourned at 8:50 p.m. The next meeting will include a general membership meeting. It is scheduled for October 21, at Johnny's Restaurant in Fife. That meeting has been changed to that date in order to avoid conflicts with shows in British Columbia..





**Holiday Dog Treat Recipe**

**Peanut Butter Puppy Poppers**

2 cups whole-wheat flour  
1 tbsp. baking powder  
1 cup peanut butter (chunky or smooth)  
1 cup milk

Preheat oven to 375°F. In a bowl, combine flour  
and baking powder. In another bowl, mix peanut  
butter and milk, then add to dry ingredients and  
mix well. Place dough on a lightly floured surface  
and knead. Roll dough to 1/4 inch thickness and  
use a cookie cutter to cut out shapes. Bake for  
20 minutes on a greased baking sheet until  
lightly brown. Cool on a rack, then store in an  
airtight container.

Female Labradors (bitches) with a Wind-Morgan, Penn Hip, or OVC clearance must not be bred before the age of 20 months, or 24 months with an OFA clearance. Male Labradors (dogs) with a Wind-Morgan, Penn Hip or OVC clearance must not be bred before the age of 12 months, or 24 months with an OFA clearance.
  - Eye clearances on both parents annually. After the dog's examination at age 10, annual examinations are no longer necessary.
  - Heart clearances will be included in the listing at the discretion of the breeder
  - A PSLRA member must own either the sire or the dam and must submit the listing for a non-member.
  - **Please contact Jill if you need a Litter Listing form, to be used for ALL litters.**
