August board meeting minutes

The meeting was called to order at 6:46 p.m. August 20, 2008, by President Stephanie Harris at the home of Becky Jack. In attendance: Stephanie Harris, Terrie Sato, Ron Perry, Jill Mahoney, Becky Jack, Dave Lawniczak, Nina Mann, Lucy Isaacson-Logen., and Kristi Clark.

Officer Reports

President: No report

Secretary: Minutes from 7-23-08 approved by e-mail. Read thank you note from Joan Fetty, who co-judged team obedience at the specialty. AKC closed out the spring HRT. Jill paid the Master National Retriever Club dues.

Treasurer: Current balance in checking is \$17,378.

Acknowledgements: Many thanks to Specialty Chair, Linda Maffett, co-chair, Jennifer Hajny; Lucy and Dean for the flowers and plants; Sonya Dudder, Diane Sullenburger, and Hugh Maffet for the raffle; and to all of the many committee chairs and volunteers who worked on the event.

Committee Reports:

Fall Agility Trials: On track—Dave.

Donations Reciprocity: No report

Specialty: The show committee received positive reports about the Marymoor site. The committee will hold a debriefing session and also discuss options for next year's site. Marymoor will be much more expensive next year because the Specialty will cover three days, and this year the club received a lower rate because it moved from Tolt MacDonald Park due to construction there.

Fall Hunt Test: Ron said that the event is listed on Entry Express. Closing date is August 28. A motion to pay for waterproof judges' sheets was moved, seconded, and approved. The board also approved the purchase of a gift for the Chewnings for hosting and providing lodging for the master judges at their home.

Old Business

January 2009 Puyallup Cluster

Supported Entry and Sweeps: The AKC compliance form for public education was signed and submitted.

IRS Filing: Club's first filing as IRS 501C7 organization will be submitted later in August (per Jill).

Event Budgets: Item was held over until next month.

New Business

Club T-shirts: The board expressed an interest in new club shirts and will submit an article to the newsletter soliciting ideas and designs from members.

Show and Go: A tentative date of January 3 was decided, pending availability of facility.

September 28 Health Clinic: Nina Mann and Mary Jane Sarbaugh will co-chair. The club will offer two new health screening tests at the clinic: (1) A test for Centronuclear Myopathy, CNM, which has been previously called Hereditary Myopathy of the Labrador Retriever or HMLR, Autosomal Recessive Myopathy or ARMD, and Type II deficiency Myopathy, Labrador Muscular Myopathy; and (2) A test of Exercise Induced Collapse (EIC). There will be a flyer in the next newsletter.

Annual Donation: Nina said that the Morris Animal Foundation is still reviewing five research grants related to whether there is a genetic cause for ruptures of the anterior cruciate ligament (ACL). She said that a funding match from another source was not likely. Nina was told a donation could be earmarked specifically for ACL research on Labs. She is looking into whether AKC or other organizations would match our donation. Other options for donations include Tricuspid Valve Dysplasia (TVD) and sponsoring the two-year training of a service dog at Summit Assistance Dogs in Anacortes. The club recently completed a two-year commitment to Summit. LRC donated \$10,000 to TVD research.

The board agreed that the amount of the donation should be \$1,000. Nina will report back to the board with a recommendation.

Open Discussion

The board discussed a general approach to event budgeting and holding to the bottom line.

Adjournment

The meeting adjourned at 9:42 p.m. The next meeting is scheduled for September 24 at the Issaquah Highlands fire station.

In addition, U-CDX Fawnhaven's Mariah CDX, AX, AXJ came out of a three year retirement from the obedience ring to earn first place in the veterans class. E.I.C. AND C.N.M.

What do all the initials mean? This year at the club's annual health clinic, we will be offering tests for both. The CNM test has been available for a couple of years, but the one for EIC is brand new.

E.I.C. (Exercise Induced Collapse) is a genetic condition. It is inherited in an autosomal recessive manner. Affected dogs can tolerate mild to moderate exercise, but 5 to 20 minutes of strenuous exercise with extreme excitement induces weakness and then collapse. Severely affected dogs may collapse whenever they are exercised to this extent—other dogs only exhibit collapse sporadically.

The first thing noted is usually a rocking or forced gait. The rear limbs then become weak and unable to support weight. Many affected dogs will continue to run while dragging their back legs. Some of the dogs appear to be uncoordinated, especially in the rear limbs, with a wide-based, long, loose stride rather than the short, stiff strides typically associated with muscle weakness. In some dogs the rear limb collapse progresses to fore limb weakness and occasionally to a total inability to move. Some dogs appear to have a loss of balance and may fall over,

particularly as they recover from complete collapse. Most collapsed dogs are totally conscious and alert, still trying to run and retrieve, but as many as 25 percent of affected dogs will appear stunned or disoriented during the episode.

Recent research by Drs. Ned Patterson and Jim Mickelson at the University of Minn. has identified the causative mutation responsible for susceptibility to EIC. The new test will help determine the frequency of this mutation in the Labrador population as a whole and in different lines.

CNM is a completely different condition. In the Labrador Retriever, a spontaneous disorder strikingly mimics the clinical evolution of the human centronuclear myopathy. The disorder segregates as an autosomal recessive trait in that pedigree.

At birth, affected puppies are indistinguishable from their control littermates but from two weeks of age, a progressive significant weight loss is observed. At one month of age, the absence of tendon reflexes is noticed and used as an early and reliable diagnosis. The age of onset of the disabling phenotype varies between two to five months. The pup will never recover from this disabling disease.

Clinical signs are progressively accentuated and generally stabilized at one year of age. In adults, the most striking macroscopic feature of the disease progression is the atrophy of temporal, cervical and leg muscles. As of today, the oldest affected dog is 13 years old and no significant premature death in the colony could be observed. Nevertheless, dogs require medical care, essentially because they suffer from respiratory complications. The age of onset of the disabling phenotype varies between two to five months with an awkward gait and a decreased exercise tolerance, associated with a generalized muscle weakness leading to a ventroflexion of the neck, abnormal postures and movements. The condition is worsened with cold.

- Heart Screening will be performed by Dr. Woodfield, ACVIM (cardiology) of Northwest Cardiology Consultants.
- EIC and CNM blood draws and identification verification will be done by veterinarians who have donated their time.

Male Labradors (dogs) with a Wind-Morgan, Penn Hip or OVC clearance must not be bred before the age of 12 months, or 24 months with an OFA clearance.
 - Eye clearances on both parents annually. After the dog's examination at age 10, annual examinations are no longer necessary.
 - Heart clearances will be included in the listing at the discretion of the breeder
 - A PSLRA member must own either the sire or the dam and must submit the listing for a non-member.
 - **Please contact Jessica if you need a Litter Listing form, to be used for ALL litters.**
