February 25, 2009

The meeting was called to order at 6:40 p.m. by President Stephanie Harris. Approved on e-mail: HRT judges' list and the budget for 2009 Specialties.

Officer Reports

President: Stephanie noted that the agenda was very full and asked members to stay on task.

Secretary: Minutes from 1-28-09 were approved. AKC approved the spring agility trial judging panel and events. Postcard announcing Tacoma Groomers show in March.

Treasurer: Current balance in checking is \$14,329.07. The

donation of \$1,000 to Dr. Paula Henthorn of the University of Pennsylvania School of Veterinary Medicine for TVD research was sent to her.

Thanks to Pat Murphy for supplying birds and stewarding them for the 2/28 field training day. **Committee Reports**

Spring Agility Trial: Cheri Levine, chair gave a report and submitted a budget. She presented the contracts for the secretary and for the agility equipment. She also asked the board to authorize the purchase of toys from Pet Edge to be given at both the spring and fall trials. A motion to approve the expenditure was moved, seconded and approved. Cheri also asked the board to approve special prizes for high in class for Labradors only on Friday and Saturday only. A motion to do so was moved, seconded, and approved. The club will provide "Dog for All Reasons" posters as a prize, plus a ribbon.



Fall Agility Trial: Gail Gegg said that Kristi Clark, event chair, is preparing a budget and also preparing for the event.

Five Series/WC: Terrie Sato and Jill Mahoney submitted a budget via e-mail prior to the meeting. A motion to approve the budget was made, seconded, and approved.

Spring Hunt Test: Ron Perry said that grounds are reserved and that he and co-chair Terrie Sato were working on the budget and finalizing the judging panel.

Sanctioned Match: Becky Jack presented the names of potential judges, and the board approved the nominees. The board also discussed potential sites for the match.

Specialty: ... the committee is looking for suggestions for the 2010 show site, since Marymoor Park will not be available next year due to an event conflict.

Judges' Selection Committee: Jennifer said the

committee is developing a list of potential judges to be sent to all-breed clubs, for their consideration in selecting Lab judges for the January Puyallup cluster shows. Names from the last round of judges' selection will form the beginning of this new list.

Puppy Mill Veterinary Care Donation: After further research, the board selected the Chuckanut Veterinary Clinic to receive the donation, because it is treating several of the dogs seized in the raid of the puppy mill. A motion to give a \$500 donation to the clinic was moved, seconded, and approved.

IRS Filing: Jill Mahoney reported that \$1,000 was due to the CPA firm who prepared the 2008 filing. A motion to approve the expenditure was moved, seconded and approved.

New Business

Newsletter: Stephanie discussed some changes in the editing, production, and mailing of the newsletter that would streamline the entire process. Sarah Fischer will continue as editor.

Dog Legislation: Ron presented a compilation of legislation of interest pending in both Washington and Oregon. This information was made available via e-mail to board and club members. Copies of individual pieces of legislation are available too.



LIST OF LITTERS BORN OR EXPECTED AS OF 2/24/09 that conform to the P.S.L.R.A. Code of Ethics.

Information is as submitted by owners and provided as a service to the public. Listings of litters are in no way an endorsement by P.S.L.R.A. of any litter or any one litter over another. Litters are removed from the list after 3 mos.

To publish **LITTER LISTINGS** in the newsletter, the following information **must be available**:

- Elbows and hips must be certified on both the sire and dam. Dogs and bitches whelped before 5/1/87 are exempt from elbow clearance requirements and will be marked OFEL N/A. Prelims are not acceptable! The board has recently agreed to accept PennHip clearances that score in the 50th percentile or higher, passing Wind-Morgan clearances, and clearances from the Ontario Veterinary College (OVC) in Canada. Female Labradors (bitches) with a Wind-Morgan, Penn Hip, or OVC clearance must not be bred before the age of 20 months, or 24 months with an OFA clearance. Male Labradors (dogs) with a Wind-Morgan, Penn Hip or OVC clearance must not be bred before the age of 12 months, or 24 months with an OFA clearance.
 - Eye clearances on both parents annually. After the dog's examination at age 10, annual examinations are no longer necessary.
 - Heart clearances will be included in the listing at the discretion of the breeder
 - A PSLRA member must own either the sire or the dam and must submit the listing for a non-member.
 - **Please contact Jessica if you need a Litter Listing form, to be used for ALL litters.**
 - All Breeders must update their litters each week with Jessica Meadows via email (labradays@aol.com) as to the sex and color of puppies you have sold. The listing will be deleted after 3 months from the first litter listing date unless she hears from you.
- 5. Mail the completed form and a check for \$10 made out to PSLRA (operating expenses for Breeder Listing and Puppy Referral Programs) to **Jessica Meadows, 8108 Abbey Pl, Arlington WA 98223**
- 6. Your litter notice will appear in the next PSLRA newsletter **if** it conforms to the Code of Ethics.
- 7. If you know that the Litter Listing and the Puppy Referral programs have helped you sell your puppies, **please send a donation to PSLRA** (c/o Jessica Meadows) to show your appreciation. These donations will all be used for Lab Rescue.
