

THE AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB ANNOUNCES THE CREATION OF THE 'AKC PUREBRED PRESERVATION BANK'

New York, NY- The American Kennel Club (AKC®), a not-for-profit organization, the world's largest purebred dog registry and leading advocate for dogs, is pleased to announce the formation of the AKC Purebred Preservation Bank, a 501 C3, not-for-profit canine genetic material repository primarily focused on frozen semen.

The mission of the AKC Purebred Preservation Bank (AKCPPB) is to ensure the viability of purebred dogs both now and in the future, particularly in low population breeds. While coordinating efforts with non-profit breed-specific clubs, the AKCPPB will educate breeders, clubs, and the public about the importance of safeguarding frozen semen and protecting purebred dog breeds for future decades.

The project began in 2021, with the recommendation from AKC's President and CEO Dennis B. Sprung that AKC explore establishing a frozen semen program which would increase gene pools, ensure saving of quality producers, and make it easy for each Parent Club to take this step for their breed. There is no cost to the owner/donor or Parent Club to donate genetic material.

"The preservation of purebred dogs is at the core of the AKC's mission," said Dr. Charles Garvin, Chairman of the AKCPPB. "Preserving the genetic materials of our dogs, via frozen semen, will undoubtedly prove valuable for breed preservation, reducing the risk of extinction in breeds with lower popularity and allow us to do the important work of improving our breeds. The AKC is pleased to offer this valuable service and look forward to the many ways it will enhance the legacy of our beloved breeds."

Preservation of genetic material is not just for the breeds with lower-than-average levels of breeding activity. Any breed could be susceptible to genetic bottlenecks or difficulties as the discovery of new diseases emerges or other crises arise. Storing diverse genetic material could address unknown future health concerns and rejuvenate breeding programs.


Rescue Fundraiser—Book Sale!

What is Heartbreak Kennel all about? It’s a biography and true crime story of Dodie Carioso, a college-educated woman from an upper-middle-class family, who becomes a well-respected potter and then turns to breeding Labradors. She sells Max, a 5-week-old puppy, to a gentleman who years later decides he can no longer properly care for him and searches for a suitable family to adopt him. After breeding for two decades, Dodie abandons nearly 100 Labradors in a northern Colorado field. Why? Does she face any consequences for the abandonment? Max and Dodie’s lives are inextricably intertwined and told in separate chapters. Dodie’s adult life is unconventional, bizarre, and shocking. Max leads an uplifting, often comical life as he burrows his way into the hearts of his adoptive family. Heartbreak Kennel is a stranger-than-fiction true story about this Labrador breeder and an engaging, intrepid Labrador. It is a poignant reminder of why our canines deserve our love, care, and respect.

Out Standing in the Field: Summer Training Season is Here!

Okay, okay, it might just be too hot for field training right now, but...

- ◆ If you do go out, train early in the morning before the heat really sets in.
- ◆ Watch carefully for signs of heat stress.
- ◆ Always keep chilled water, some type of shade, and other cooling equipment on hand.
- ◆ Don't assume water work will keep the dog cool if the water is warm too.
- ◆ Be on the lookout for signs of cyanobacteria blooms in water (toxic algae). It can't always be easily distinguished from normal algae. Even dried mud may harbor it.
- ◆ Hot sunny weather can be very demotivating for retrievers, particularly those with heavier bodies or packing extra pounds, so keep sessions fun and short.
- ◆ Now would be a great time to formalize hold and fetch commands as well as work on other obedience, either indoors in the AC or outside in a shady spot in the evening.

To: **All Clubs Licensed to Host Retriever Hunting Tests**

Subject: **Talking to Your Dog in the Junior Test Level**

This is to inform your club of a change to the *Regulations & Guidelines for AKC Hunting Tests for Retrievers*. This change is effective August 1, 2023.

This change allows handlers in the junior test level to speak quietly to their dog and pet their dog for reassurance anytime during the junior test level. This is intended to be encouraging to new handlers and new dogs and to help them gain confidence at this beginner level. This will only be allowed at the junior level.

The exact wording of this change is underlined and in bold and will appear in the next printing of the regulations as follows:

Chapter 4. Standards for Junior, Senior and Master Hunting Tests, Section 6.

(3rd paragraph)

The handler of the working dog shall remain silent from the time handler signals for the first bird to be thrown until the Judges release the dog. **Except handlers in the junior test level at anytime may speak quietly to their dog and be allowed to touch their dog for reassurance or positioning.**

- ◆ The All Around Dog Award is part of the foundation of PSLRA and has been offered to qualifying dogs since 1983. By earning a title in multiple venues, these dogs have proven they are deserving of the PSLRA All Around Dog Award. To Qualify, a dog must have earned the following three items:
 - ◇ AKC, CKC, International or other conformation championship
 - ◇ AKC, CKC or other Obedience or Rally or Tracking or Agility Title
 - ◇ AKC or CKC Hunt Test Title or JAM at a licensed field trial or Working Certificate

- ◆ Versatility Dog Award winners distinguish themselves in three different non-conformation categories, truly demonstrating the “versatility” of the Labrador Retriever breed and proving they are deserving of this award. To Qualify, a dog must have earned a title in three of the following venues:
 - ◇ Hunt Test or Field Trial
 - ◇ Obedience or Rally
 - ◇ Agility or Dock Diving
 - ◇ Tracking, Barn Hunt or Nose Work
 - ◇ Coursing, Fast CAT or Similar
 - ◇ Weight Pull or Similar
 - ◇ Therapy Dog Certification

"Reign", owned and handled by Julie Germano, earned her International Championship and Best of Breed at the Lynden IABCA show.




International CH Country Classic's Rumor Has It CDX PCDX BN RE NA MXP MJP NF XFP CC WC
